Short Snorter

A short snorter is a bank note usually autographed and exchanged between service men and women during World War II and the Korean War. Short snorters are a "vanishing breed" of artifacts once treasured by their original owners because they forever bound them to others who had like experiences in war. Short snorters do not have much value to the general currency collecting community as they are usually severely worn or damaged. Tape was used to string them together in a roll as they were carried at all times.
